Since Uganda's independence in October 1962, there has been a lot of prejudice towards the Northerners & the region by all people, especially the Central people.

Milton Obote (The 2nd President of Uganda) and the infamous Idi Amin are the most prominent sons of the region. The fact that this region produced these two, as well as Joseph Kony, made it very hard for the Northern people to be freely embraced.

## PREJUDICE:

Since my childhood, every bad thing has been associated with Northern Uganda. Some people even believe that Satan was born in this region!

Since becoming a born again Christian in 1992, I personally have come to believe that all these were huge misconceptions and deception.

These brethren are very sweet children of God and faithfully serving the Master!



## **DROUGHT, SIDELINED BY GOVERNMENT, BACKWARDNESS.**

With the prolonged seasons, no known mineral resource, and being sidelined by the government developmental and service programs, the region is the poorest in Uganda.

The Northern people are known to be very hard working and tough. This explains why most military and security personnels all over Uganda are northerners!

**LAND TENURE SYSTEM:** Is communal.

**POPULATION STRUCTURE:** Most of the people are subsistence farmers despite the terrible droughts.

**GEOGRAPHY:** The region has 30 districts, with several smaller tribes. The biggest tribe is Acholi.

**GULU:** Is the economic and administrative center of the region. The north is approximately 10 Million people.

## THE JOSEPH KONY FACTOR & THE SPIRITUAL ATMOSPHERE:

For over 25 years, the region has gone through very difficult times and great turmoil. Up to this day, we have many people whose lips, ears, limbs, etc were chopped off! Thousands of families lost their beloved people and experienced unbelievable suffering! We thank God this war has stopped and people are settling back to their homes, which are mostly made of grass and mud.

- Most people struggle with wounds, hurts, etc.
- Many people are struggling with unforgiveness.
- Through the years, many ministries and charity organizations have entered Northern Uganda to plant churches, do charitable work, etc.

The government of Uganda through its Northern Uganda development initiative has done a lot. These tough people are strong prayer warriors.

The spiritual needs are still evident everywhere. There is a huge hunger and deep thirst for the WORD of God. Most pastors are very poor. The existing churches are very, very vulnerable!

## **GOD CALLS OUR MINISTRY INTO NORTHERN UGANDA:**
